



To Whom It May Concern:

Casella Waste Management Inc. has been appointed as the authorized waste hauler for the Northern Berkshire Solid Waste District. Our role encompasses the transportation of municipal solid waste (MSW) from the towns' transfer stations to the Pittsfield transfer station, situated at 500 Hubbard Ave, Pittsfield, MA. Upon arrival, the waste is weighed on a certified scale prior to being unloaded onto the tipping floor. Subsequently, it is loaded into tractor trailers for further transport to the Clinton County Landfill located at 286 Sand Rd, Morrisonville, NY 12962.

In addition to managing MSW, Casella is responsible for the collection of recyclables from the towns. The commingled recyclables are transported from the towns' transfer stations to the Pittsfield transfer station, where they are weighed and unloaded. Following this process, the recyclables are loaded into tractor trailers for delivery to the Auburn Materials Recovery Facility (MRF) at 15 Hardscrabble Rd, Auburn, MA 01501.

Furthermore, Casella is charged with the collection of paper products from the towns. The paper is transported from the towns' transfer stations to our facility in Cheshire, located at 485 S State Rd, Cheshire, MA 01225, where it is weighed and unloaded. After processing, the paper is baled at our facility and subsequently shipped via tractor trailer to Sonoco at 200 Water St, Holyoke, MA 01040.
